The guesswork is eliminated when managers receive reactions about what they are doing well and targeted, specific actions describing how to improve. As one leader in the project shared, "Once I was clear on what to do, I worked with my employee group to make the needed changes."

In addition to sharing their case study results, Dr. Hart and Ms. Carlascio-Budd will educate session attendees on the importance of clearly defining roles, responsibilities and work allocation to make the most effective use of the internal HR Business Partner collaborating with an external Organization Development consultant. Dr. Hart shares, "This session is all about how to improve relationships to achieve greater work force productivity." Session attendees can expect to be active participants during this highly engaging and interactive session.
